

Grants Policy

- i. The Charity will only make grants in support of Sighthounds and Sighthound Crosses in the South of England, for veterinary/therapeutic treatment.
- ii. Applications may be made by Dog Rescues, individual Dog Owners, or the Veterinary Practice in charge of the dog's care.
- iii. For a Dog Rescue to qualify, they must demonstrate an active rehabilitation and re-homing policy.
- iv. All applicants must fill out the official Southern Lurcher Lifeline Grant Application form.
- v. The Trustees will assess each application and contact the Rescue/Owner/Veterinary Practice if additional information is required.
- vi. Preference will be given to Dog Rescues that are registered with the Charity Commission for England and Wales.
- vii. Preference will be given to individual Dog Owners whose dog(s) is(are) insured.
- viii. The Trustees reserve the right to decline an application if they feel that the treatment proposed may cause the dog unwarranted suffering.
- ix. Once approved, the grant will be paid direct to the Veterinary Practice or associated therapist as appropriate.
- x. Southern Lurcher Lifeline and/or its Trustees will not be liable for any costs or charges over and above the sum of the grant.
